



ELIGIBILITY AND BENEFITS

- 1) Under the Provincial Nominee program of the province of Saskatchewan, anyone who has a personal/combined (spouse) net worth of CAD 300,000 (INR 1.35 cr) is eligible to obtain PR(White Card) in Canada. All dependent children and the applicant, along with spouse will be residents within 16 to 18 months of the application.
- 2) Applicant is required to have a minimum of 3 years of entrepreneurial experience.
- 3) The net worth includes immovable properties such as house / flat, land including agricultural land, AND movable properties such as fixed deposits, bank deposits, good will of the business, LIC policies, jewellery, stocks etc.
- 4) The applicant does not require having knowledge of English language and need not have a formal education. In this category, the applicant does not have to undergo any educational examinations.
- 5) Even if the applicant had been refused the American visas, he can still apply for this program and the success ratio is 90%.
- 6) The Applicant will be required to make the payment of the application fees directly to the Canadian embassy and the Bank.
- 7) After getting your PR and residing in Canada for 3 years, you will be eligible to apply for Canadian citizenship. Once you are a citizen you can move freely to US, UK/Australia etc without visas.
- 8) You and your family will enjoy the benefit of free medical all your life once you obtain your PR.
- 9) Your children will study free until grade 12, and will be able to get an interest free loan from the government for further education (which is 25 % of the International fees) lodging and boarding upto CAD 18,000 per year.

PROCEDURE / FEES STRUCTURE:

- 1) Once all the documents are in order and ready to be submitted. The first application will be made to the PNP for assessment.
- 2) Once the application is made, in about a month the PNP will approve the first application and will ask for the formal application, at this time a non-refundable fee of \$2500 is to be sent with the application for processing.
- 3) There may be an interview scheduled over the phone in India or in person in Canada, depending on the findings of the PNP officer.
- 4) After acceptance, the applicant is required to make a refundable deposit of CAD 75,000 with the government of Saskatchewan; this deposit is refundable if the client opens a qualifying business within 2 years in the province of Saskatchewan with a minimum investment of CAD 150,000 and owning at least 33.33% of shares of that business.
- 5) After the deposit is made the Government of Saskatchewan will issue a nomination letter.
- 6) Once the Nomination is received, the applicant will be required to submit an application to the Federal Government. The applicant will have to pay fees of CAD 550, spouse CAD 550 and CAD 150 for each dependent.
- 7) After 6 months you will then be required to submit medical and security clearances.
- 8) Once cleared visas will be issues in about 2 months.

Note:

The visas can be rejected based on the following 4 reasons:

- 1) The applicant, spouse or their children are medically unfit. (aids, cancer, T.B. etc)
- 2) The net worth is acquired as a result of smuggling, Arms or illegal activities.
- 3) There is a criminal record against any family member.
- 4) The documents produced before the pnp/embassy is forged.
