



### **Eligibility and Benefits**

- 1) As per the American EB- 5 program, anyone who has a personal/combined (spouse) net worth of USD 1 million (INR 7 cr) is eligible to obtain a Green Card in America. All unmarried dependent children under the age of 21 and the applicant, along with spouse will be residents within 24 to 28 months of the application.
- 2) The net worth includes immovable properties such as house / flat, land including agricultural land, AND movable properties such as fixed deposits, bank deposits, good will of the business, LIC policies, stocks etc.
- 3) The applicant is not required to have knowledge of the English language and need not have a formal education. In this category, the applicant does not have to undergo any educational examinations.
- 4) Even if the applicant had been refused the American visas, he can still apply for this program\*.
- 5) The Applicant will be required to make the payment of the application fees directly to the American Government. Our consultation fee will be due in stages and are refundable\*.
- 6) After getting your Green Card and residing in USA for 5 years, you will be eligible to apply for American citizenship. Once you are a citizen you can move freely to Canada, UK/Australia etc without visas.
- 7) You and your family will have the freedom to live/work/travel in and out of USA without the risk of being denied entry by an immigration official at the port of entry.
- 8) Your children will study free until grade 12 in public schools, and pay less tuition for university and college, referred to as “in-state” tuition or “resident” tuition. Savings are considerable and in most cases, they are 2 to 3 times lower than what one would pay as an international student
- 9) Your children will have the right to apply for government sponsored financial aid for education.

## **PROCEDURE / FEES STRUCTURE:**

- 1) Once all the documents are in order and ready to be submitted. The applicant will be required to submit a questionnaire and forms to the regional center for approval.
- 2) Once the application is approved by the regional center, the applicant is required to remit USD 555,000 in escrow to the regional center, USD 15,000 in escrow to the lawyer and the 1<sup>st</sup> installment of the consulting fees.
- 3) The above documents are then submitted to USICS in form of an I-526 petition with a processing fee of USD 1,500. It takes about 15 to 18 months for the I-526 approval.
- 4) Once the I-526 approval is received, the legal team will do an application of DS-260 "Immigrant Visa Electronic Application" to the National Visa center, at this time a processing USD 345 per family member is to be paid to the American government and the 2<sup>nd</sup> installment of the consulting fees. It takes about 6 to 8 months to be called for an interview.
- 5) You and your family will be called to the nearest US consulate for an interview, at this time a processing fee of USD 165 per family member is to be paid to the American government.
- 6) Once you clear the interview you will be given a sealed envelope and will be immigrants of the United States of America. At this time the 3<sup>rd</sup> and final installment of the consulting fee is due.
- 7) The conditional Green card will be delivered to the address that you give at port of entry when you enter the USA.
- 8) One year and nine months later the legal team will do an I-829 application (Removal of Conditions) this takes about 12 months. At this time a processing fee of USD 3750 and USD 85 per family member is to be paid to the American government.
- 9) Once the conditions are lifted the investment of USD 500,000 is returned back to the applicant and the non conditional green cards are issued.

### **Note:**

The visas can be rejected based on the following 4 reasons:

- 1) The applicant, spouse or their children are medically unfit. (aids, cancer, T.B. etc)
- 2) The net worth is acquired as a result of smuggling, Arms or illegal activities.
- 3) There is a criminal record against any family member.
- 4) The documents produced before the embassy is forged.
